到達目標及びテーマ	This class will give students many opportunities to develop their speaking and listening skills and enjoy both short and longer talks. These talks will include both informal discussions and more formal interviews where students will alternately have the chance to fulfill the role of interviewer and interviewee. Students will practice interviewing and understand the role of interviews when conducting research. Another skill to be covered is reading as there are extensive textbook interviews to practice and learn from.				
授業の概要	The main objectives are to improve students' speaking and listening abilities. Concurrently, students will gain confidence as they become more adept at initiating questions and expanding on responses. At the same time, students will have many chances to practice reading, and become aware of the relationship between speaking and writing. Importantly, students will gain confidence in English as they gain insights into the working world.
