到達目標及びテーマ	Students will develop their English abilities, mainly by engaging in content-based activities. The course content covers the cultures of 15 countries. Students will come to understand and, to an extent, discuss stereotypes, national cuisine, customs, and basic historical or geographical facts. Students' English will improve via their efforts to understand and engage in the content. There will also be opportunities for conversations and discussions, a process in which students will gain confidence in their English ability, especially listening skill.					
授業の概要	Although the class and textbook include all four skills, a special focus will be placed on listening. The main weekly activity will be an extensive dictation activity whereby students learn the culture of that week's country. Students listen to the eight dictation sentences three times before working with a partner to check and articulate the meaning. Other activities will include vocabulary preparation, relevant discussions, and readings about that country's famous person and famous places.
